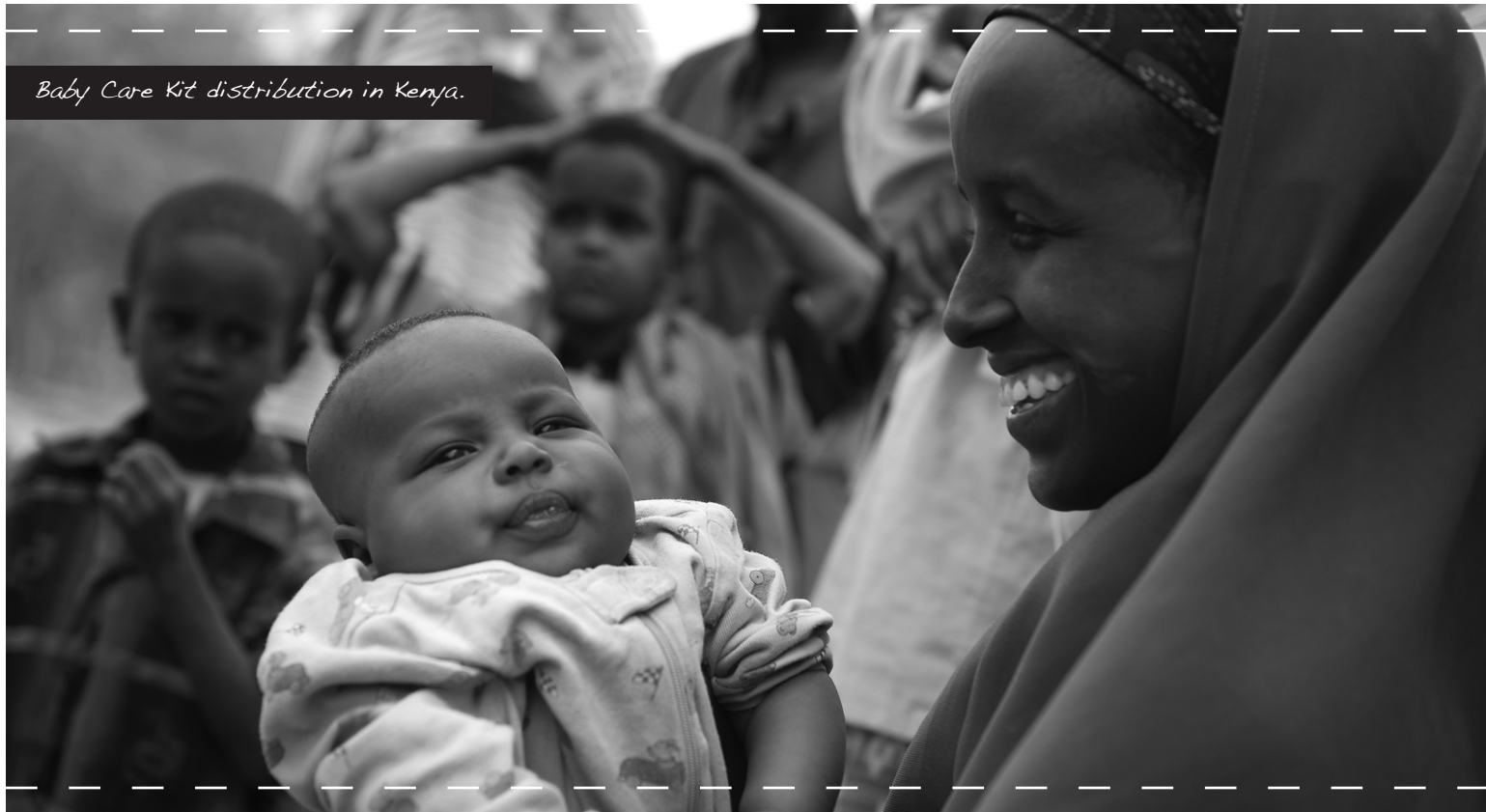

# diaper tip sheet

*for* LWR BABY CARE KITS

With the popularity of disposable diapers in the United States it can be difficult to find cloth diapers to include in LWR Baby Care Kits. If you are having trouble finding cloth diapers in stores, you may find new or like-new diapers at yard sales or online through websites such as Craig's list. Several kit-makers have recommended [alltogetherdiaper.com](http://alltogetherdiaper.com) as a good source for diapers, pins and even socks. The site offers discounts on items to be donated to humanitarian aid and relief organizations.

Also spread the word in your congregation; someone may have cloth diapers stored away that they would be happy to donate. As long as the diapers are in like-new (no stains or holes) condition they can be included in the Baby Care Kits.

Otherwise, diapers can be made from flannel by using pinking shears to cut pieces approximately 22" X 27". If the flannel is especially lightweight, consider making the diapers two layers thick. It may also be necessary to zig zag the edges to prevent raveling. ►
